Pain relief product makes use of high-tech fabrics

What is Pain Checker?

Pain Checker is a pain relief product made of patent pending fabrics which use an exclusive mixture of conductive carbon yarns with either stretch nylon or polyester and are worn or placed on the body.

In 1996, Crystal Textile Group engineered the fabric to exhibit superior static control properties for use in surgical operating rooms and electronics manufacturing clean rooms. Quite by accident, the inventor Arthur Goldberg injured his elbow (known as the funny bone) and instinctively placed his opposite hand with this fabric on the elbow. To his surprise, the pain went away. He removed the fabric and pain reappeared. Arthur did this several more times, all with the same result. Thus, Pain Checker was born.

The unique combination and array of

the conductive carbon yarn structure and the non-conductive nylon/polyester causes the fabric to act as an antenna, picking up electric charges from the body as well as atmospheric charges. This acts as a battery emitting its own current that reduces or cancels the current of injury in the body, which is the pain signal. This pain relieving action mimics the science of a transcutaneous electrical nerve stimulator (TENS) device that is approved by the FDA for use in pain management. Pain Checkers electrical charges are not externally powered by battery or household electrical current as are the TENS units. Also, Pain Checker emits 1 million times less amperes than externally powered units. This assured Pain Checkers safety and allows it to be used continually as opposed to the TENS 20 to 30 minute treatments.

David Price, head trainer for the New York Jets Football team, has endorsed Pain Checker. It has been used since the 2000 season as an adjunctive therapy, with continued good results.

Additionally, Duke Clinical Research Institute is involved running trials for pain relief, and North Carolina State University Veterinary College is testing Pain Checker on animals for pain relief efficacy.

Pain Checker is cost effective. The products can be washed by hand or machine with Woolite in warm water. No fabric softener should be used and the products will last for years. Very important to mention, absolutely nothing is ingested into the body. Pain Checker is used externally, for pain relief.
